


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 44.2 million vaccines have been administered, with 87.1% of the target population completing the process (67.1% in the population under 18 years and 92.1% in the population over 18 years). Chile stands out for being the country with the largest share of population vaccinated with booster doses, reaching 57 per 100 inhabitants. In total, 10.9 million booster doses have been administered.



Chile has received more than 49.2 million vaccines, mostly from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.

COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending





From the first of October, the curfew and the quarantine phase no longer apply to the entire national territory. Currently, 87% of the national population is in Paso 4.(Step 4)



ICU patients have slightly increased, critical bed capacity has moderated.


Critical beds


COVID-19 related Deaths

People, Data through January 2nd.




ICU patients have mantained during the last week in all age groups. The average age of ICU patients has stabilized.
